Changes to Course Schedules

Victim Impact Panel (VIP): The March 29 panel will be held in three separate sessions on the same day with a maximum of 10 people each, as ordered by the Governor. Pre-paid students will be given attendance priority:

- First Session: 10:00 am to 11:15 am (arrive by 9:30 am)
- Second Session: 11:45 am to 1:00 pm (arrive by 11:15 pm)
- Third Session: 1:30 pm to 2:45 pm (arrive by 1:00 pm)

Defensive Driving course schedule is changing until further notice:

- Monday through Saturday, 9:AM-3:PM
- NO Defensive Driving Course will be held on Sunday.

Anger Management: The March 23 – 26 class has been be canceled.
