

ATTENTION: Please read this notice carefully for important information about ADAPT/ABC's current class dates, cancellations and operating procedures.

For everyone's safety, ADAPT/ABC's operations and program schedules have been modified to comply with the most recent [COVID-19 Executive Order issued by Governor Abbott](#), and rules for safe practices published by the national [Centers for Disease Control \(CDC\)](#).

Classes are offered on a restricted basis, limited as to group size to facilitate social distancing practices. An appointment and pre-registration are required until further notice. Students must contact ADAPT/ABC to pre-register and receive instructions prior to attendance.

Precautionary measures and mandated social distancing are observed on the premises. Only symptom-free persons who have not had contact with a sick person will be allowed to attend. Class size is restricted to allow at least 6 feet of space between students. The use of a mask or face covering is urged for all persons at all times while conducting business on the premises or attending classes at ADAPT/ABC.

DEFENSIVE DRIVING (6-hour Driving Safety Course, TDLR CP206,C0673)

DWI REPEAT OFFENDER INTERVENTION PROGRAM (32-hour DWII/DROP 1354)

- The next **Repeat Offender Intervention Program** is set to begin May 25, meeting on Mondays and Tuesdays, 6:30 to 8:30pm.
- The next weekend program will begin June 20, meeting on Saturdays and Sundays, 3:30 to 5:30pm.

VICTIM IMPACT PANEL (V.I.P.)

· Until further notice, the Victim Impact Panel (V.I.P.) is conducted as a live, facilitated presentation of recorded video testimonials by victims of drunk driving. The presentation is available throughout the week on an as-needed appointment basis.

· In addition, the V.I.P. is also offered approximately once a month on a Sunday in multiple-group seatings to accommodate demand. You must pre-register for this program and reserve a time slot. The next upcoming Sunday V.I.P. day will be **May 31, 2020**.
